Applications for admission to Fellowship of the College on the basis of International Recognition (Category 4) must be supported by letters from two financial Fellows of the College. The supporting letters must attest to the candidate's clinical competence as well as his/her professional attributes. Candidates will be interviewed by the Chief Censor in Radiology or Radiation Oncology (as appropriate) and a Councillor on their arrival in Australia and/or New Zealand. The College reserves the right to contact the candidate's referees, previous places of employment and other relevant bodies in order to obtain additional information, as required.

Admission to Fellowship under this provision will be recommended to the College Council only upon the candidate taking up a position in Australia or New Zealand.

### **Criteria**

To qualify for international recognition a candidate must score a least 15 points from the following menu.

	<b>Points</b>
• Author/Editor of textbook on radiology/radiation oncology (the latest edition of the textbook must be less than 10 years old and held in the majority of accredited training program libraries in Australia and New Zealand)	<b>5</b>
• Author of at least 30 papers in the peer reviewed literature (first author of at least 20)	<b>5</b>
• Editor of Medline-listed journal and/or member of the Editorial Board of at least two such journals	<b>5</b>
• Current holder of an overseas professorial appointment in a College recognised medical school/university or a successful applicant to an Australasian professorial post	<b>5</b>
• Recipient of an academic prize/medal from a major radiological society	<b>3</b>
• Delivery of a named lecture at a major radiological society scientific meeting	<b>2</b>
